<u>Hebrews: Jesus, Second to None</u> <u>Chapters Three & Four: Discussion questions for individuals and life</u> <u>groups.</u>

- 1. Look at your daily planner or time schedule and your checkbook. What do they tell you about the priorities you are setting for your life? Where do they witness to Jesus' place in your life?
- 2. Describe the spiritual condition of the first recipients and readers of the Book of Hebrews.
- 3. How does this chapter support or modify your understanding of the doctrine of personal salvation?
- 4. What forces or people in the modern world tempt you to follow them and slacken or give up your commitment to Jesus?
- 5. How does the warning not to fall short of God's rest affect your life and your experience of salvation?
- 6. What benefits do you receive by entering in and experiencing God's rest in Christ?
- 7. What does it mean when a person who has made a public profession of Christ as Savior and has worked effectively in the church suddenly disobeys Christ and expresses disbelief in him?
- 8. Describe the rest that remains for believers from Hebrews 4.
